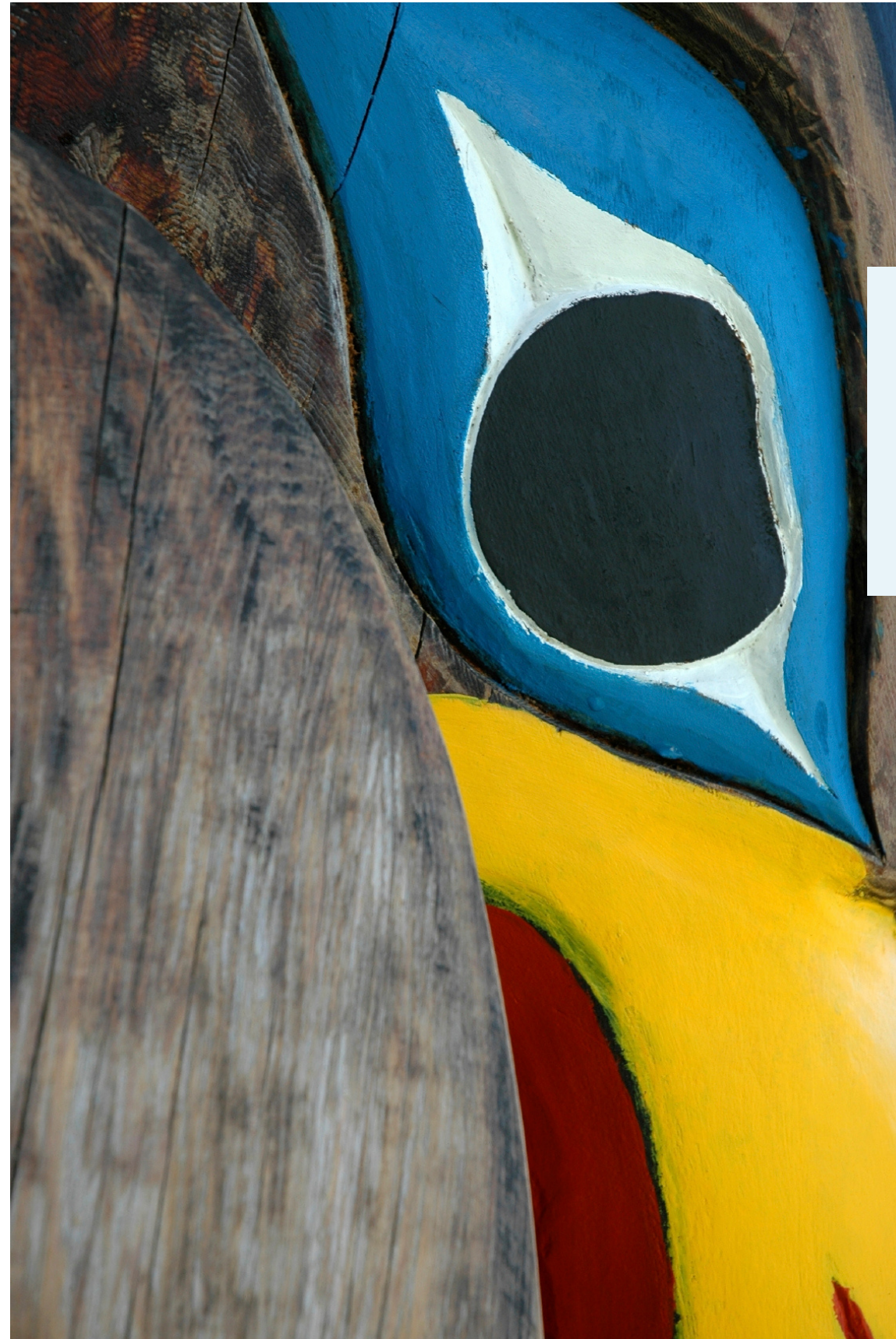




Indigenous Recruitment & Retention
