In partnership with the Executive Medical Director (EMD) as a co-lead, you have a critical role in seeking to understand and respond to the health needs of the population within the Geography. This includes understanding the complexities of the Geography that includes both rural and remote populations and includes a focus on the wellness, health and care needs of Indigenous peoples.

Building on the strength of your leadership team, you will direct the development and implementation of program service delivery models, business plans, priorities, goals and operating budget, including people, financial and physical resources. The Executive Director will also develop and foster collaborative partnerships throughout Island Health to deliver the highest quality of care in a patient centred way.

The geography covered by this position has a population of approximately 125,000 people living in 50 communities, including First Nations communities. There are approximately 2700 full and part time staff working across the geography in a total of 41 Island Health sites and 17 affiliate sites. Within this geography, there are three community hubs; Campbell River, Comox Valley and Mt. Waddington, Strathcona. This position is also responsible for Nutrition Services and is the BC Emergency Health Services liaison.

Qualifications

A level of education, training and experience equivalent to Masters degree in a health-related discipline and at least ten (10) years' progressive senior management experience in health care/program management.

Skills:

- Demonstrated knowledge of Indigenous health care needs, services and issues as well as knowledge of the culture, protocol and traditions of Indigenous peoples to ensure respect, diplomacy and tact to honour established and new relationships as a representative of the health authority.
- Sound working knowledge of planning concepts related to budgetary, staffing, quality and strategic initiatives.
- Demonstrated strong leadership skills
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Ability to adapt readily to rapid and changing environments and the ability to adapt with initiative.
- Ability to interact professionally with various levels of staff both internally and externally.
- In-depth understanding of Health Services and Operations.
- Physical ability to perform the duties of the position.
