What do we measure and why?

Computed Tomography (CT) is one of the most widely used diagnostic imaging tools for serious diseases of all body organs. The images produced by a CT scan are a critical source of information for diagnosis, and to determine treatment required.

Waiting for a scan and diagnosis can cause anxiety and delay treatment; therefore, wait times should be minimized.

This indicator measures the percentage of CT exams that were performed within defined time periods ("benchmarks" based on urgency.) The benchmarks are:

- Stat – within 1 day;
- As Soon As Possible – within 7 days;
- Semi-Urgent – within 30 days; and
- Routine – within 60 days.

All four priority levels are included in this indicator.

Follow-up CT exams that must occur within a specified window of time are not included in this measure.

What is the target?

The target is that 85% of exams be performed within the benchmark timeframe.

Higher rates are better.

How are we doing?

As of November 2024, Island Health was not meeting the target for CT exam wait times.

What actions are we taking?

CT access and capacity is being expanded where possible. Focused efforts to schedule and scan patients who have been waiting the longest are underway.
